

Oak Wilt... Found in Bayfield County in 2018

Why Care About Oak Wilt?

- Creates hazardous trees
- Reduces private land value
- Reduces timberland value
- Negative aesthetic impact

It can often be prevented and controlled.

Oak wilt is most commonly spread along road rights-of-way.

NO cutting, pruning, mowing, or anything that can cause damage to an oak tree from April 15th through July 15th.

Pictures above show how rapid oak wilt can kill an oak tree. It can kill a tree in 3 to 4 weeks after first signs of oak wilt symptoms.
