Standing committee reports:

Executive Committee:

Mooney Dam County Park and proposed Town of Barnes campground with the following updates:

- Shriver reported that additional information on the Town of Barnes campground is needed to make an accurate evaluation of the proposed campground.
- Discussion regarding the request by the citizen's group for support of their objections over the proposal to expand Mooney Dam County Park by 19 camping sites and moving the boat landing. Motion by Shriver to author a letter communicating FOECLA's concerns over specific issues, consistent with FOECLA's mission, in the proposed Mooney Park campground changes. 2nd by Olson, motion carried.

Water Quality:

Wiesner provided an update on BAISS Boat operations on Upper and Middle Ecu Claire Lakes as well as the discovery of curly-leaf pondweed near Clearwater resort. DNR permits will be needed to mechanically remove curly-leaf pondweed in Lower Eau Claire Lake.

Membership/Outreach

McGinley presented a draft agenda and PowerPoint slides for the annual meeting. Shriver and Kolberg are on the ballot for renewed board positions, and Martin and Wilbers are on the ballot as new board members. This will be voted on by FOECLA membership at the July 16 annual meeting. Motion by Scharlemann, 2nd by Wiesner to approve the ballot as proposed, motion carried.

Education

On June 25, the Boating Safety event was held at Tomahawk Park. Rain fell up until 10:00 when the program started. Milliken expressed disappointment in attendance due to poor weather, lack of public interest and minimal advertising. DNR wardens Peters and Katelyn Juza provided a summary of boating laws and answered questions from the audience.
