

SAFETY BOAT RESPONSIBILITIES AND SUPPLIES

Stationary or patrolling safety boats should be positioned at the perimeter of students in canoes:

- 1. Be crewed by at least two people that are ready to:
 - a. watch students.
 - b. rescue and problem solve as needed.
- 2. Have cell phone contact and whistle. **Three long** whistle blasts signal "emergency and help needed."
- 3. Have a plan for a capsized watercraft (ensure safety and tow to shore). Students should stay with their canoe and be assisted to shore.

Safety Boat Equipment Supply Plan

- 1. Two crew members wearing PFDs (one is driver).
- 2. Throw ring on a rope.
- 3. Cell phone.
- 4. Whistle for signaling for help.
- 5. Tow rope.
