

Tree Lab Module – timing example

There are three Tree Lab rotations in the morning

- For each of the rotations, the students will split into two main groups
 - Tree boring and clinometer
 - Tree ID
- Clinometer and tree boring will teach 10 minute sessions, 4 times each rotation (12 times for the day)
- Tree ID will teach for 20 minutes, 2 times each rotation (6 times for the day)

10:00-10:10 (10min) Clinometer (Group 2)-2 students//Tree Bore (Group 5) -2 students

10:10-10:20(10min) Clinometer (Group 5)-2 students//Tree Bore (Group 2)-2 students

10:00-10:20 (20min) Tree ID- 6 students (Group 8, 11, 14)

10:20-10:30 (10min) Clinometer (Group 8) 2 students//Tree Bore (Group 11, 14) 4 students

10:30-10:40(10min) Clinometer (Group 11, 14) 4 students//Tree Bore (Group 8) 2 students

10:20-10:40 (20 min) Tree ID- 4 students (Group 2, 5)

3rd rotation 10:40-11:20 (40min)

10:40-10:50 (10min) Clinometer (Group 3, 6) 3 students//Tree Bore (Group 9) 2 students

10:50-11:00 (10min) Clinometer (Group 9) 2 students//Tree Bore (Group 3, 6) 3 students

10:40-11:00 (20min) Tree ID-2 students (Group 12, 15)

11:00-11:10 (10min) Clinometer (Group 12) 2 students// Tree Bore (Group 15) 2 students

11:10-11:20 (10min) Clinometer (Group 15) 2 students//Tree Bore (Group 12) 2 students

11:00-11:20 (20min) Tree ID-5 students (Group 3, 6, 9)

11:20-11:30 (10min) All student Wrap up with Faculty in Patio area
